



Legal Awareness Program

Objectives of the Program:

- To stimulate healthy intellectual conversations on sensitive topics such as domestic violence, child marriage, dowry, sexual harassment, rape, and so on..
- To sensitize participants about the legal provisions that govern these issues.
- To inform the participants about their rights as well as corresponding duties.
- To raise awareness of and reduce violence against women and children.
- To bridge the gap between Law and Society.

I was afraid that if anyone ever knew about it, they would hate me; the way I hated myself for I thought maybe something was wrong with my body. Though sexual harassment is a topic that our parents rarely talk about, it is an everyday phenomenon manifesting in different forms and degrees. It is important to act in defense when somebody touches your body in a way that you don't like, or throws nasty comments on you making you feel uncomfortable.
