Short Overview

Results

We prepared presentations on intercultural topics to deliver at BPW events in Europe and Egypt, and covered a definition of culture, stereotypes, authenticity, and intercultural learning in our first presentation at the EBWA conference in Cairo in 2018. In October 2019 we attended the African Regional Conference of BPW and presented "The Power of Intercultural Empathy and the Danger of a Single Story".
