Description

The Digital Economy and Society Index (DESI) 2018 has placed Italy at fourth position from bottom of the general ranking in Europe.

In November 2018 BPW Italy, by North East District, was planned and launched **Digital on Board** a project **to support the awareness of digital needs** among all the Members of BPW Italy.

The aims of the project are:

- -developing a new approach to digital field
- standardization of all key processes
- saving time
- filling the digital gap
- increasing digital skills

Target Group

The project has involved 304 Clubs and all the seven Districts of BPW Italy

Phases:

The first phase of the project (November 2018- March 2019) was focused on digital needs and standardization of key secretarial processes awareness.

All the Districts of BPW Italy (7) and all the Clubs (304) have been involved.

During this period was given "digital pills", detailed communications and guidelines to reach the goals.

The first aim was dematerialize all documents related to Secretary and storage them in a USB support in order to create a digital archive.

The statistic datas about the first phase of the project will be collected in September 2019. Based on the results obtained the others phases of Digital on Board project may be planned.
