

AWARD about Women's Rights

promoted by the BPW International Standing Committee Membership
and the member Adriana Sabato

Aims

To make the association, its activities and aims known to the younger generation through the award.

To fight violence against women.

To collaborate with schools.

The international and repetitive aspects of the award will make it recognisable and famous over time.

Prize

Cash prize to highlight the best theme or class work on:

a) Violence Against Women, or

b) Women's Rights

Times

The Prize will be awarded annually.

Therefore each year a different club, chosen in rotation by the Standing Committee Membership, will organise the competition at local level.

Date of the event

The date of the award ceremony should be:

a) 25 November, International Day against Violence against Women, or

b) 8 March, International Women's Rights Day.

Partners

The award will be given to girls in their final year of high school.

The school concerned will be chosen by the local club through appropriate contacts with the school headmaster.

Organisation

a)

- By February of the school year preceding the year of the award, identify the school to be involved and decide on the title of the theme or class work;

- By May of the school year preceding the year of the award, collect the work done by the students;

- By the end of September of the school year in which the prize will be awarded, choose the winner through a committee composed of representatives from BPW and the school;

- To organise the award ceremony on 25 November.

b)

- By September of the school year in which the prize will be awarded, identify the school to be involved and decide the title of the theme or class work;

- By January, collect the work done by the students;

- By February choose the winner through a Commission composed of representatives of BPW and the School;

- By 8 March organise the award ceremony.

Organisational support

Support can be provided by the members of the Standing Committee Membership.
